A paper template is available at this <u>link</u>. All submissions will undergo a rigorous peer-review process (regulations at this <u>link</u>). Accepted papers may be proposed for either oral presentations or poster sessions.

To maximize participation opportunities, each accepted paper must be presented by a different registered conference attendee.

PUBLICATION

Accepted papers will be published in a volume edited by **Springer** and indexed in SCOPUS.
